The Stone Forest is a world of stone peaks, stalactite-stalagmites, stalagmites, subterranean rivers and underground limestone caves. We will have an **electronic car**



ride to get more fun. The place is home to the Sani people, a branch of the industrious and brave Yi minority. As born singers and dancers, they are also skilled in embroidery, and we will spend some time at **Silk Store** to see their crafts. Go back to Kunming by private coach. Our day will be ended with **Nan Ping Walk Street**, the classical and very famous commercial street in the city.

The Third day is opened with **Green Lake Park** - the most popular park in the city. Since 1985, it has become the home for red-beaked seagulls traveling long from Russia. The park's natural combination of emerald-like lake & weeping willows are also liked by local people. Coming up is a fabulous Tea Ceremony on the nation-renowned **Puer Tea**. Today's prayers will be held at **Shun**

Cheng Mosque. First built in early 1425, it is one of the most famous Mosques in China, and the head quarter of Islamic Association in Yunnan Province. After some shopping time at **Health Care Center** and **Jade Shop**, we will have a blast shopping at **Daguan Commercial Area**.

brief tour to **Jinri Pavilion** (meaning of "the closest building to the sun"), it formerly served as the south gate of Kunming. Stop by at **Jade Store** before lunch. Today's prayer will be held at **Yong Ning Mosque**, followed by some shopping time at **Fresh Water Center**. Today's program will be ended with **Yun Fang Shopping Street** – one of the most popular place among foreign guests.
