Day1 KL – Xi'an

Arrive in Xian at 23:15. As one of the oldest cities in the world, Xian is enriched with glorious history and culture. Not only the birthplace of China, it is also the origin of human civilization in Asia and the center of prehistoric period. Upon arrival, our guide will greet you with a big smile and accompany to hotel for check-in assistance.

Day 2 Xi'an (B/L/D)

Our wonderful trip will start with an outside tour to **Ancient City Wall**. First built in early Ming Dynasty (1378), this 600 years old wall also served as a strong defense system. And a tasty Halal lunch will be ready for us. Today's Zohor prayer will be held at the famous **Great Mosque** – one of the oldest and largest in China. Not far is **Muslim Street**, where you will see various Halal snacks. We will then go to **Big Wild Goose Pagoda Square**, which is famous for the pagoda and the music fountain ranked Asia's Number One. Stop by at **Silk Factory** to get the finest silk products. Our day will be ended with a casual stroll on **Great Tang All Day Mall Street**.



Day 3 Xi'an (B/L/D)

The morning opens the high light of the whole trip – the visit to **Museum of the Qin Terracotta Warriors and Horses** - one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in the world. With three exhibition halls, the largest of which is 180 meters by 60 meters, housing the continuing excavation of an army of 8,000 terra-cotta soldiers and horses that guard the tomb of Qin Shihuang, the very first emperor of the unified China. And a tour to **Three-Color Ceramic Factory** helps to know better the process of making terracotta. Another “must -see” place is **Drum & Bell Tower Square**. The two towers were built in early Ming Dynasty (more than 300 years ago), and have been acknowledged as one of the landmark of Xian. Go back to hotel for rest.



Day 4 Xi'an – KL (B/L/D)

Check out in the morning. To see every side of the incredible Xian – capital city of 13 dynasties, **Shaanxi Provincial Museum** is the perfect choice. With coverage of 65,000 square meters, it presents a grand picture of the city. Next, we will spend some time at **Jade Center**, where you will be impressed with the art of jade carving. Today's prayer will be held at **City Southern Mosque**, who is more than 500 years old. The rest of the day is for bazaar shopping -- **Southern Ancient Culture Street** and **The Great Tang West Market Commercial Street** are highly recommended. In the evening, we will go to Xian Yang International Airport for departure flight home.

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Day 3 Xi'an (B/L/D)



Our Third day in Xian start with a tour to **Ancient City Wall**. First built in early Ming Dynasty (1378), this 600 years old wall also serves as a strong defense system. A whole picture of the city is under your eyes when strolling along the walkways. Coming up is **Xian Museum**, who is famous for **Small Wild Goose Pagoda**. Built in Tang Dynasty, this 13-story structure is considered the precious architectural legacy. After some shopping time at **Jade Shop**, there will be a well prepared Halal lunch for us, followed by Mosque prayers. Next, we will go to **Muslim Street**, where you will see various Halal snacks. And our day will be ended with a casual stroll at **Great Tang All Day Mall Street**.



Day 4 Xi'an (B/L/D)

As the capital city of 13 dynasties, Xian is proud of rich and glorious historical site. **Da Ming Palace National Heritage Park** is the best among them. Built in the great Tang Dynasty (705 AD), it covered an area 4 times larger than Forbidden City in Beijing, now consisting Dan Feng Gate, Lin De Temple, Han Yuan Temple and Tai Ye Pool. Stop by at **Silk Shop**. After prayers at **Da Xue Xi Mosque**, we will take a look at **Hancheng Lake National Scenic Area**, which will taking you back to the ancient China capital. The evening will be spent at **Drum & Bell Tower Square** – the symbol of Xian.
